



Helping Hands Community Food Pantry

We have a wonderful opportunity to partner with the local Messianic Synagogue (Beth Emunah) in a service project to reach out to the hungry families in the Conejo Valley. The Helping Hands Community Food Pantry hands out food donated from local markets through the program Food Share - Ventura County to more than 150 people (50 families) in need each week. From 12 to 1pm every Wednesday, the pantry distributes food bags to anyone in the community who needs it during these difficult times.

Each Wednesday volunteers go to seven stores and collect food. Around 10am, volunteers go to the synagogue (at 5312 Derry Ave N, Agoura Hills, CA 91301) and sort the food by food groups. At noon, the food is distributed. The pantry keeps growing steadily with new families added weekly. Please pray for the team as many are battling physical ailments.
