There's someone in the Old Testament of the Bible whose life has a lot to teach us about justice. In this 4-week series, the story of Joseph will help us see that **justice is love in action** and that, when we're wronged by others, we can **hold on to hope**, trust that **integrity can withstand injustice**, and learn to practice justice that **restores what's broken**.
