Current Sermon Series:

Present Grace, Future Promise

Today's sermon, titled "Points of Light," is by Conejo's own Haylie Douglas.

In Hebrews, the writer is trying to encourage the people of a hurting church and does this in part by spending an entire chapter reminding them of people of faith that have gone before them. When we focus on those around us who are being points of light, it is easier for us to become points of light. Right here in our church, we are surrounded by numerous people shining the light of Christ. We can see Christ in them, because we see love in them.


